Dear Anthony

I am writing to confirm that following the initial assessment and the subsequent meetings I had with you at your home, along with the time we both spent with Dr Farid, the extended assessment process has drawn to a close.

We spoke briefly after the multidisciplinary team meeting on the 14/06/2017 when I outlined to you that we were considering your suitability for the EDIT (Early Detection Intervention and Treatment) Service. This was specifically with a view to providing you with support for what appears to have been a challenging time for you, allowing you access to a trained CBT practitioner that would be primarily about supporting you to manage stress. You expressed at the time that you felt this would not be helpful and that you had received excellent psychological input from Andy Hayle previously.

Upon my return from annual leave you had communicated via e mail that you had withdrawn yourself from Mental Health Services. you expressed some concerns about your involvement with Mental Health Services in the e mails you have sent and I have provided you with the contact details of the customer care department.

In the e mail you sent last week on the 14 th of June 2017, you have requested a formal diagnosis of your mental state. **Dr Farid is of the view that you do not display psychotic symptoms nor are your experiences delusional in nature.** Through the assessment process, we have been able to get an understanding that you experience significant stress. This stress relates to the complex legal matters you have taken great time to explain, that involve the Military and also issues from Yemen in the Nineties relating to the 9/11 attacks, along with difficulties you experience in your family relations.

I am writing to invite you to attend an Out patients Appointment with the Community Mental Health Team (CMHT) Psychiatrist. I am aware from our telephone conversation that you do not want to engage with the CMHT and do not believe you are experiencing difficulties with your mental health.
